

PROPOSED STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO ADOPT PUPIL PERSONNEL SERVICES CREDENTIALED PRACTITIONERS

This notice is to provide information of public interest about a proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). Proposed SPA #23-0027 seeks to adopt Pupil Personnel Services (PPS) credentialed practitioners, in the Medi-Cal program, as a distinct provider type to provide, within their scope of practice under state law, behavioral health (mental health and substance use disorders) services to children and youth at a school site, as part of the Children and Youth Behavioral Health Initiative, statewide, multi-payer, school-linked fee schedule.

DHCS estimates that the annual aggregate Medi-Cal expenditures for adopting the PPS credentialed practitioner as a distinct provider type will be budget neutral.

The effective date of the proposed SPA is January 1, 2024. All proposed SPAs are subject to approval by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).
